Re: Financial Institution Data Match Program (FIDM) – Arizona Financial Institution Sign-Up

Dear President or Compliance Officer:

The Financial Institution Data Match Program (FIDM) is a provision of Public Law 104-193, the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act, which requires that states enter into agreements with financial institutions for the purpose of identifying the financial assets of child support obligors. Additionally, Arizona Revised Statutes §25-521, §25-523 and §25-524 were created to support Arizona's FIDM compliance.

The State of Arizona is pleased to announce that through the commitment and collaborative efforts of the Division of Child Support Enforcement (DCSE) and the local Arizona financial community, the FIDM Program has been instrumental in the collection of over 11 million dollars in unpaid child support for Arizona's children since the Year 2000.

Your completion of the enclosed agreement and subsequent participation will ensure FIDM compliance from both DCSE and your institution. This information will be a valuable resource in our efforts to collect past due child support.
