The Personal Responsibility and Work Reconciliation Act of 1996 (PRWORA), a comprehensive plan for change in the nation's welfare system, launched an innovative provision to increase child support collections known as the Financial Institution Data Match (FIDM) program. Supporting legislation in Idaho, per Idaho Statute 32-1601, requires the Child Support Enforcement agency to enter into agreements with financial institutions for the purpose of implementing the Financial Institution Data Match program in Idaho.

Our records indicate that your financial institution is not yet participating in this program. We would like to get you started as soon as possible. Enclosed are the materials you will need to participate in Idaho's FIDM Program, which include: the Idaho Financial Institution Data Match Memorandum of Agreement and the Financial Institution Data Match specifications Handbook, as of October 25, 2004.

Informatix Inc. is under contract to the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare to manage the Financial Institution agreements and perform the quarterly data match.
